What information are we collecting?

Why are we collecting your Information?

We are collecting your information as you are a participant in the National Cardiac Surgery Research Trials Initiative.

How we will use this information?

We will use this information in collaboration with the BHF Clinical Research Collaborative IT Platform to contact you, either by post or email, with regards to the project.

What is the legal basis for processing the information?

To process your personal data, the legal basis which is relied upon is consent set out in Article 6 (1)(a) of the GDPR.

(a) the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes;

If we are sharing your information with others who are we sharing it with?

Your data will not be shared by third parties.

How long we will process your information for?

We will retain your information for 2 years. Your information will be deleted 2 years from the time we first process.

Your information will be stored electronically on a secure database and will only be accessed by certain members of the project team.
