

Admission Statistics

Statistics for admission to the A100 Medicine MBChB course and A199 Medicine with Foundation Year course at Leicester Medical School.

A100: we have 293 places available for 2026 entry: 18 for Overseas fee-paying students and 275 for Home.

A199: we have 38 places available for 2026 entry: 15 for candidates from the East Midlands and 23 for candidates from the rest of the UK.

A100 MBChB, Five-Year Course

- 'Graduate applicants' are those who have completed a degree or are in their final year of their degree
- 'Non-graduate applicants' are those who have not completed a degree or are not in the final year of a degree
- Access to HE Candidates are not included in these tables (there were five such applicants for 2026 entry).

Please note: graduate applicants were ranked separately from non-graduate applicants for invitation to interview purposes because of differences in the scoring system. However, all applicants will be ranked together when looking at interview scores.

* The score listed is the lowest score required to be guaranteed to be invited to interview. There were some applicants who scored lower than this who were invited to interview. Those applicants were in a borderline group who had their application assessed in a tie-breaker situation. Please note: our scoring system can change every year, and as such, this score should in no way be deemed to be a minimum required every year to receive an invite to interview.

Applicants who applied with **achieved A-Levels grades** who met the entry requirements and had a UCAT score in the top five deciles (for Home fee status) and top three deciles (for International fee status) were invited to interview.

Contextual data is used to provide equal opportunity to applicants from all backgrounds on our A100 course in the following ways.

- Applicants who successfully complete a Realising Opportunities Programme (ROP) or a UKWPMED programme were automatically invited to interview providing they met all our minimum requirements and had a UCAT score in the top seven deciles. If successful at interview, these candidates may be made an

adjusted offer at A-level.

- Applicants who were in a borderline group pre-interview were assessed using the following contextual data:
 - a) IMD decile 1 or 2 (i.e. quintile 1)
 - b) UCAT bursary flag
 - c) Being a carer
 - d) Refugee status
 - e) Time in Local authority care
 - f) Receipt of free school meals for more than six months
 - g) Receipt of 16-19 bursary

as well as their whole UCAS application and UCAT result.

These contextual criteria will also be used for those in a borderline group post-interview, along with any interview comments.

Offers will be given in order of interview score and assessment of all aspects of the application, including the personal statement and reference.
