# **Honorary Graduates**

Fawsley St John-Stevas Norman, Doctor of Laws 1991. Lord St John of Fawsley died on 4 March 2012 aged 82. Stevas's main academic achievement came through his double involvement with the Economist (1954-59), as a many-hatted correspondent and editor of the writings of Bagehot, the Economist's founder. Stevas's career reached its highest points as Arts Minister towards the end of Edward Heath's Conservative government and as leader of the Commons with the arts brief again under Margaret Thatcher. Given a peerage in 1987, he guickly became a leading figure in the fundprocessing and patronage-giving aspects of the arts. In 2010, he was appointed an adviser on arts, religion and the constitution to Sky.

# Harding Roy, Doctor of Laws, 1995.

Sir Roy Harding died in 2011 aged 87. He graduated from King's College London at the end of the Second World War and worked in ballistics research before becoming a Teacher. He married Audrey Larkin, a languages teacher, in 1948 and the couple had three children – Alan, Hilary and Paul. In 1950, Sir Roy moved into local government, working in education administration in county councils. During his career he helped expand further education courses, paving the way for the Open University, and many other further and higher education institutions in England. He was awarded the CBE in 1978 and knighted in 1985.

# Holmes Richard, Doctor of Letters, 2006. Professor Richard Holmes, died on April 30 aged 65. He was one of Britain's most distinguished military historians, and a distinctive broadcaster with a soldierly mien, imparting knowledge and enthusiasm in equal measure.

#### LaPidus Jules, Doctor of Laws 2000.

Mr LaPidus died in 2012. He received MSc and PhD Degrees in medicinal chemistry at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He accepted a positions at Ohio State University as an Assistant Professor, rising to be Professor, Associate Dean of Research and Dean of the Graduate School, before accepting the position of President of the Council of Graduate Schools, a Washington, D.C.

based organization. He remained in that position until his retirement. In 2002, he initiated a series of talks about recorded classical music in Alexandria, Virginia. He served on the Board of Trustees of Chamber Music Columbus, Chamber Music Connection, as well as on the Board and Cultural Affairs Committee of the OSU Retirees Association.

## Lowther John, Doctor of Laws, 1998.

Sir John Lowther died on 11 April 2012 aged 87. In 1942 Lowther joined the King's Royal Rifle Corps, losing a foot in the Second World War, yet this did nothing to inhibit his enjoyment of life or his irrepressible sense of humour. Lowther stood as Conservative candidate for Belper, Derbyshire in 1964 and again in 1966, losing on both occasions. Turning to local politics, he was elected to various positions in Northamptonshire County Council in 1970, serving until 1984. Lowther continued to enjoy shooting and other country pursuits, remained a keen cricketer and played tennis and golf until his death. He also took part in numerous charity walks. Sir John Lowther is survived by his wife and by their son and two daughters.

# Midgley John, Master of Art, 1978.

Mr Midgley died from cancer on 19 May 2007 aged 72. He enjoyed a wideranging career as a Director in theatre, television and radio. He was responsible for some of the earliest episodes of Z Cars on BBC-TV and the television adaptation of The Wars of the Roses. Midgley took charge of the Phoenix Arts Centre, Leicester, in 1968, and became the first Artistic Director of the Leicester Haymarket. In his later years, Midgley gave acting lessons to young singers at the Royal Opera House, and taught and directed at Rada. He was also a volunteer for the Samaritans.

Scott Helen, Distinguished Fellow, **2005.** Died on 26 January 2012 at the age of 95. She was the first recipient of an Honorary Distinguished Fellowship from the University of Leicester in 2005.

# Stack Neville, Master of Arts, 1988.

Mr Stack died suddenly on 27 October 2012. He worked as editor of the Leicester Mercury from 1974 to 1987. He had also served as sub-editor on the Daily Express in the 1970s.

Wood Kenneth, Doctor of Science, 1980. Mr Wood died in August 2011 aged 88. He worked for about 30 years as a general surgeon at Leicester Royal Infirmary, retiring in 1990. He helped raise money to build the hospital's Post Graduate Medical Centre and played a leading role in establishing the University of Leicester's Medical School. He leaves two daughters, Pamela and Caroline, a GP, and two granddaughters.

#### **Associates**

Jeffrey Helen. Mrs Jeffrey died on April 14 2012 aged 103. Her father was Astley Vavasour Clarke, a prominent physician who helped establish the University of Leicester. Mrs Jeffrey devoted her skills to public service, serving as a magistrate in Harborough from 1946 to 1978, 15 of those years spent as bench chairman. She was a prison visitor at Rampton and Gartree prisons and during the 1980s worked as a guide at Rockingham Castle.

**Ashley Jack.** Lord Ashley of Stoke died in 2012. Honorary Patron of the Richard Attenborough Centre. A former Labour MP for Stoke-on-Trent, he represented the city for 26 years until he was made a peer in 1992. He lost his hearing following an ear operation, but continued his career in the House of Commons. Founded Defeating Deafness now known as Deafness Research UK in 1986. Ashley took the cause of the disabled to parliament and won victories for victims of the drug Thalidomide, among others. Ed Miliband described him as "an extraordinary campaigner for equal rights for people with disabilities".
