	BATH → [æ]	last – [læst]	Occurs once
	PRICE → [ɑI]	time – [taɪm]	Occurs once
	Vowel variation: /ɪ/ → [i]	participate – [pɑːtɪsipeɪʔ]	In third syllable. Occurs once
	/∧/ → [D]	one – [wɒn]	Consistent

/eɪ/ → [e]	they've – [ðεv]	Consistent
/aʊ/ → [aː]	Foundation – [faːndeɪʃən]	Occurs once
T-glottalisation	artwork – [ɑːʔwɜːk] out – [ɑʊʔ] great - [ɡɹeɪʔ]	Frequent but not consistent; word- medially and finally
K-glottalisation	drink - [dɹɪŋʔ] actually – [aʔʧəliː]	Frequent but not consistent
L-vocalisation	possible – [pɒsɪbʊʷ] fields – [fiʊʷdz] old – [ɒʊʷd]	Occurs once
