## Adding the PARCA-R questionnaire as a survey in a REDCap project: User guide

1. In your REDCap project, Select "Designer" from the left hand menu



## 2. From the options in the centre of the screen, click on "Upload". This will open a pop-up window:

3. Select "Choose File". This will open an Explorer window allowing you to select the PARCAR\_Redcap.zip file (it is important to select the .zip file, and not either of the .csv files inside it).

This should return you to something looking like this:
