

At the University of Leicester we're fortunate to benefit from a vibrant mix of students from a diverse range of social and cultural backgrounds. The online submission form is an expression of interest/registration to attend the Recruitment Fair and doesn't confirm employers have an allocated space at the fair. Once you have received confirmation from us via email that you have been allocated a space at the fair you will need to let us know as soon as possible if you are unable to accept the place offered and wish to withdraw your attendance. Any organisation that fails to notify us of withdrawal from attending the fair and does not attend, or notifies us of non-attendance with less than 10 working day's notice will still be liable for the booking cost agreed on the expression of interest form.

#### IN RESIDENCE SESSIONS

In Residence sessions are a great way to meet students who are interested in working for your company. They offer you the opportunity raise your profile, share expert advice and answer questions about your organisation and recruitment processes in a one-to-one format. They can also be used as an informal first-stage interview process.

The Employer in Residence sessions aim to:

- Provide students with expert advice from an employer, alumni or organisation they are interested in.
- Allows you to meet with students on a one-to-one basis
- Offer practical support such as advice on preparing for interviews and assessment centres
- Provide individual feedback to students on CVs, applications

Employers exhibiting at our Recruitment Fair, the In-Residence sessions are a great opportunity to follow-up with any interested students after the event has taken place. We can arrange a suitable location on campus for any further conversations to take place with keen and proactive students.

If you are interested in taking part in an In-Residence session, please speak to a member of the team and we can discuss the most appropriate format including timescales to make this beneficial for your organisation to help connect you to our student talent.
