Employer Sustainability Guidance for Career and Employability Events & Activities here at the University of Leicester:

We are very proud of our track record here at the University of Leicester (UoL) in terms of our commitment to sustainability. In terms of context, in the 2024 QS World University Rankings for Sustainability we recently came 185th in the world and 37th in the UK!

UoL also ranked 49th out of 1591 universities in the world, among the top 3.08% of institutions at the <u>2023 The Impact Rankings</u> for our contribution to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG). In addition, UoL was one of the first universities in the UK to sign the <u>SDG Accord</u>, which is a commitment made by academic institutions to one another to do more to deliver the goals across all operations and beyond.

For the University of Leicester sustainability is a key strategic goal and one of the University's four <u>strategic guiding principles</u> and our <u>Environmental Sustainability Masterplan</u> is set against 5 theme areas of *Responsible Consumption, Energy, Travel, Biodiversity and Health & Wellbeing*.

Not only is sustainability a significant University goal but our students are also very climate conscious and research has shown that almost all believe employers should be taking action on environmental sustainability and 71% of our students think that it is important to work for an organisation that makes a difference to social and environmental issues (<u>Sustainability Skills Survey</u> results 2024).

Therefore, we've put together some guidance and top tips to help you with regards to sustainability, when visiting us for any careers & employability activities or events.

Sustainability commitment	As mentioned above sustainability is a key strategic goal and commitment for us all. In most cases, this will resonate and align with your own companies' goals and commitments too. As Citizens of Change , our approach is holistic – from reducing our negative environmental impacts to increasing our positive handprint by engaging with local, national and international policymakers at all levels. In addition, 80% of UK students are looking for roles that also support the Sustainability agenda and so recruitment fairs and events are a great way to showcase this, i.e through work you may have achieved within local communities or through accreditations. Waste	 Only 12% of our waste was sent to landfill in 2022/23 and priority is given to recycling and energy recovery. You can watch a video about what happens to our waste here. We offer many disposal points across campus for non-recyclables, recyclables, vapes, food and liquid waste. We would appreciate your support to avoid contamination. Internal signage is re-used as much as possible and also "props" such as the flags, showing what opportunities your company might offer.
Green Careers:	 Research has shown increasing numbers of UK students are interested in "green careers and roles" – do you have any opportunities that you can promote at our fairs? Considerable numbers of students nationally report climate or eco anxiety so be prepared for their questions and interests in your company's "green" agenda
