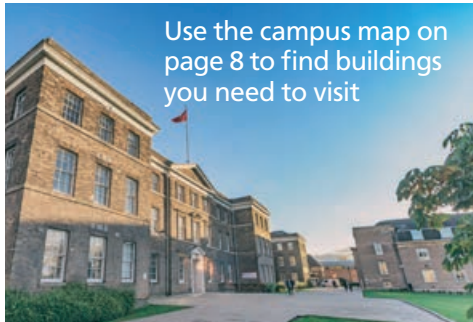
## OUR STUDENT AMBASSADORS

There's so much to see and do on our Open Days. To make the most of your time here, we suggest coming in with a plan of attack. Here are a few tips:



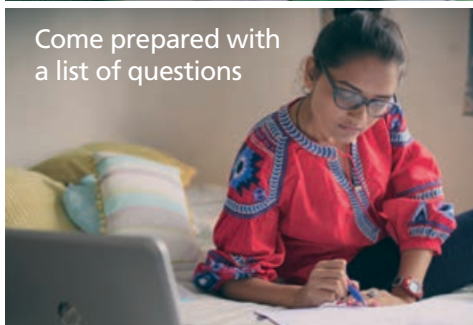

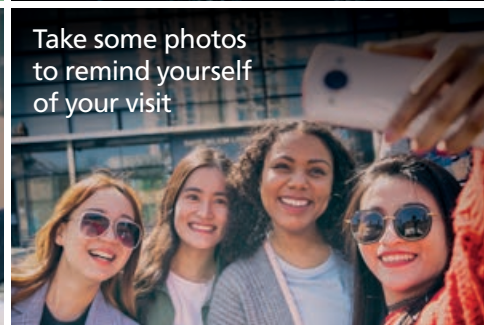

# WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE

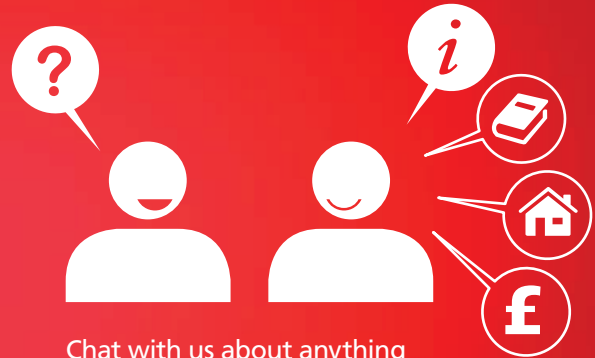

Our Atrium Café in the heart of the building serves hot snacks, salads, sandwiches and drinks.

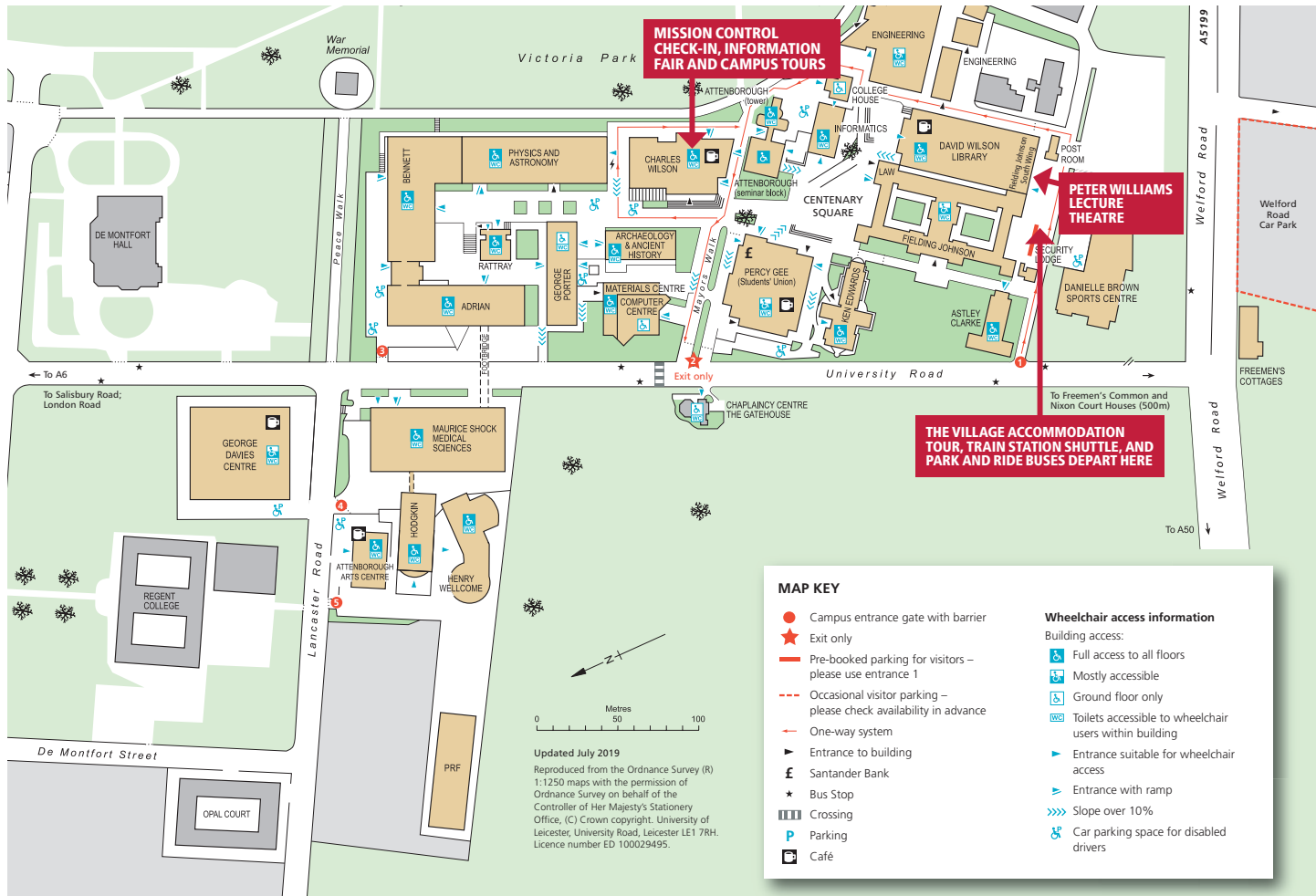
## 'Taste of Leicester'

## Food and drink

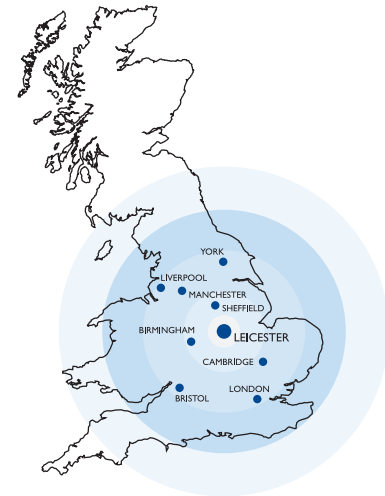
Like a true student city, Leicester has plenty of trendy cafes, restaurants, bars, pubs and dessert parlours. You'll also find some high-street staples and old favourites.
