



1. Please check the eligibility criteria at <https://le.ac.uk/student-life/undergraduates/fees-funding/scholarships-discounts/al-yafei>
2. Please note that annual tuition fees range from £14,630 to £18,045 according to your degree. You should allow a minimum of £820-870 per month for living expenses, including accommodation. The Al-Yafei International Undergraduate Scholarship offers only **partial** funding for your studies. If you are awarded this scholarship you will need to pay the balance of your tuition fees and living expenses.
3. Make sure that you answer all the questions on the application form. Please type or write clearly in blue or black ink. You must sign the form personally (not third party or agent).
4. Ensure that you have included all of the following documents along with your completed application form:
 - i. Copies of your certificates and transcripts/grades from all your academic qualifications obtained since age 16. These should be in English.
 - ii. A personal statement (typed if possible) of no more than 500 words, detailing academic performance and your reasons for applying to the University of Leicester and the Al-Yafei International Undergraduate Scholarship.
 - iii. A reference from your school or a suitably-qualified person which provides an informed and academic assessment of your suitability for the Al-Yafei International Undergraduate Scholarship (this can be the reference provided in support of your UCAS application).
5. Make sure that you include all relevant information even if it has already been submitted with your application for a place at the University.
